

AfS Medical Volunteers in Bangladesh

In October, an incredible team of AfS volunteers transformed children's lives at Shaheed Tajuddin Ahmed Medical College Hospital (STAMCH) in Gazipur, Bangladesh. The team screened 115 children and completed 85 surgeries and 44 dental procedures on 68 patients. That's a total of \$343,321 in donated medical services made possible by the supporters and volunteers of AfS.

The AfS team has been providing remote training to local medical teams in Bangladesh for several years, and took this fantastic opportunity to provide face to face vocational training. The local staff are passionate about learning and showed inspiring enthusiasm to cultivate their expertise.
